SCORES:

Players and their current point totals will be displayed here.

The win-loss record shows how many award winners have been picked correctly.

POINT GAIN:

The number of points each player gained by wagering on the most recent winner.

The nominee(s) picked by each player to win the current category will be listed here. A blank entry indicates an even split of points across all nominees—a vote for “everything” (or, “nothing”).
